Counseling Services We Need Consent Above to Provide:

- Check-In or brief talk with a counselor to discuss issues such as peer conflict, having big feelings, experiencing grief or loss, barrier to learning, or changes at home.
- Beginning of year mini meeting survey
- Completing student need assessment
- Participating in lunch bunch (in order to foster relationship building).

Class Counseling Lessons

All Students will continue to receive counseling lessons within their class covering topics such as:

- Self-Awareness/ Self Regulation
- Friendship / Kindness
- Conflict Resolution
- Bullying
- Decision Making/ Goal Setting
- Assertiveness/ Empathy
- Team Building
- Communication/ Collaboration
- Career Development



Some other services counselor provide that require specialized consent:

- Small Group Counseling to build skills/ tools
- Ongoing individual counseling
- Positive behavior interventions and support plan
